


A massive 'thank you' to all the grown-ups for supporting pirate day, from talking to them about their day and supporting with costumes.

### FREE PARENT SESSION ON ONLINE SAFETY AND MEDIA LITERACY – Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> June

### **OPEN TO ALL PARENTS**

Loudmouth Education and Training is a reputable theatre in education company that has been creating and delivering safeguarding programmes in schools for over 30 years. Loudmouth have been working with Ofcom to create a new programme on online safety and media literacy, and will be delivering this to our Year 6 pupils on Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> June



Keen to find out more? On the same day as the Year 6 session, Loudmouth will deliver a free, 45-minute, awareness raising session for parents and guardians, giving you the opportunity to see the drama that the children are going to watch - you'll also receive some great tips and ideas on online safety and how to spot unreliable content online. This will help if you want to learn more about media literacy – not only for yourself but also to help with any discussions you may have with your child about the programme and any of these issues.

The move to secondary school can be a tricky time, not just for children but for parents too! It can be a challenge trying to work out when is the right time to allow children to have access to a smartphone, how to manage screen time (something we're sure many parents battle with on a daily basis!) and how to protect and support them as they spend more time online.

This 45-minute session will show you the drama element and run through some key info and tips that are taught, including:

- Online Safety
- Spotting Dis and Misinformation
- Impact of Online Comments on Wellbeing (including Misogyny)
- Communication with Parents about Screen Time
- Where to get Help and Support

The free parent session will take place in the Main Hall at 9am – 9.45am on Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> June. We look forward to seeing you there!



Mrs. Wren's reading group are working towards getting the book badge – here is the information in case any other children want to apply for one.




Do you love books and reading? If you do, this is the badge for you! To earn this badge all you need to do is tell us about a book you've enjoyed reading recently and draw a character or scene from the book. We'd also love to hear about any books that have sparked your imagination. So, what are you waiting for? Pick up a book, explore your school library, or become a member of your local library and you could be on your way to earning your very own Book badge!

### Blue Peter Book badge application

To earn this badge, you must:

- Be aged between 5-15 years old.
- Apply for your Book badge online using My Blue Peter.
- Ask your parent or guardian to <u>set up a BBC child account so you can</u> <u>use My Blue Peter</u>. Please remember your username and password, as you'll need these to log in and request your ID card, once your badge has been issued. *Please note: Each child applying for a badge via My Blue Peter need their own individual log in, for example a family with two children, will need two BBC child accounts for each child, so we can log their badges individually.*
- Ask your parent or guardian for permission to apply and ask them to <u>read the Privacy Notice.</u>

- Get your parent or guardian to help you fill out your form and personal details.
- Tell us about a book you have read and what you think about it. Maybe you liked the characters, or perhaps you enjoyed going on exciting adventures in faraway places.
- Upload your illustration of a character or a scene from the story. This could be a drawing, painting or even digital artwork.
- Let us know what other books and authors you have enjoyed reading and why.

Please remember that children can wear black or grey plain shorts or summer dresses (navy gingham or plain grey/black) for school. This is particularly useful as the weather heats up.

Please remember to label your child's clothes with their name as this helps us reunite items with their owners.

#### Summer heat

Please ensure your child has a water bottle with them every day.

For hot sunny days please also ensure they have a hat and have applied sun cream before school.

### Hay Fever

As the Hay Fever season kicks in, please ensure your child has taken any precautionary medication before school and that we have additional medication in school.

### Changes to charges for Summer Term

As you will know, the changes in costs for goods and services have steadily been going up, and now with the increases in National Insurance, many of our suppliers have increased charges.

This has had a significant impact on our school meals provision and as such, from the **summer term Dinner money** will now be **£2.70 per meal**.

We have been able to maintain the same charges for breakfast club, after school club and snacks for the Summer Term.
